



RENT BOARD FEES THAT CAN BE BANKED

** The landlord may collect this portion of the rental unit fee from the tenant(s) in occupancy on Nov. 1 of the specified tax year. However, tenants in residential hotel units owe only one-half this amount.*

- ◆ Only one rental unit fee may be collected per unit per tax year, regardless of the number of tenants occupying the unit.
- ◆ Rent Board fees since November 1, 1999 may be banked and collected in a later year. Fees for years prior to 1999 cannot be retroactively demanded.
- ◆ A tenant's failure to pay the Rent Board fee as demanded is not a just cause for eviction under the Rent Ordinance. The landlord will have to go to Small Claims Court in order to collect an unpaid Rent Board fee from a tenant.
